IN RE: MEDIATOR QUALIFICATIONS AND DISCIPLINE REVIEW
 BOARD

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The Mediator Qualifications and Discipline Review Board (hereinafter “Board”) is responsible for accepting grievances against certified and court-appointed mediators; determining good moral character for applicants and currently certified mediators; determining probable cause regarding grievances filed against certified and court-appointed mediators and applicants for certification; conducting hearings regarding certified and court-appointed mediators and applicants for certification; and disciplining certified and court-appointed mediators and applicants for certification.

The members of the Board serve four-year, staggered terms. The Board is authorized to have up to 84 members. It has four geographical divisions: Northern, Central, Southeastern, and Southwestern. Two members have resigned from the Board, seven members are ineligible for reappointment due to term limits, and the terms of nine members have expired. Additionally, there is no longer a

need to fill more than the minimum number of dependency and appellate seats given the number of complaints received involving that type of mediator in recent years. Therefore, some mediator members who hold more than one type of mediator certification are being moved from seats in which there are already the minimum number of required members to fill seats in categories that require a minimum of three mediators.

In accordance with rule 10.730, Florida Rules for Certified and Court-Appointed Mediators, the following individuals are appointed to serve as members of the Board for the terms indicated.




